With school starting back up this is a reminder that if your child uses the Rosey bus for transportation you need to make sure they are here by 8:00AM so they have enough time to eat, go to the bathroom and get ready to leave. Also, if your child is on our bus, please make sure they know how to use their seatbelt. There isn't enough time for the bus driver to buckle everyone up or unbuckle fourteen kids on the bus. This is all part of being prepared for the "big" school. There is no eating or gum chewing on the bus either. All supplies are to be in their backpack so it doesn't get left on the bus. We cannot return to school with things they left on the bus.

If your child is absent from school that day or you picked them up early, please contact us so the bus driver won't be sitting there waiting for him and then they

are late for the other schools. There is a lot involved in transporting the kids to and from school which is why we need your help with these matters.

A lot of the kids are moving up to their new group in September. Some kids will have anxiety from their move but they will adjust quickly. A few hugs from their teacher and they will feel very comfortable. Some suggestions to make this a little easier is to talk about it the night before, create a fun goodbye, don't linger around and control your emotions.

We do have some exciting news regarding the lunch and breakfast menus. If your child is a vegetarian or eats only Halal Tommy is now able to order Halal foods from our vendor and also some items that are vegetarian. If you would like more information stop in the office and hopefully, we can answer your questions.
