Pre-Kindergarten / Young 5's Curriculum

The Pre-Kindergarten / Young 5's will be working hard on many subjects to help prepare them for Kindergarten. They will have many new challenges and learn new skills as well as review some of the old ones. The children will work on fine motor skills, handling scissors and cutting on lines, writing upper and lower case letters with proper handling of their pencil. Daily story time will also include: retell, character, setting, problem, events, predictions and ending. Counting to 100 by 1's, 2's 5's and 10's.

Our curriculum will include Art, Exercise, Holidays, Language Arts, Math, Music, Science and Social Studies.

Art: crafts, colors, coloring with crayons, markers and color pencils. Precise cutting with scissors, pasting and play dough.

Exercise: large motor skills, creative movement, climbing, throwing, catching, running, hopping, skipping, jumping and dancing, indoors as well as outdoors.

Holidays: traditional, Halloween, Thanksgiving, Christmas, Hanukkah, Kwanzaa, the New Year, Chinese New Year, Valentine's Day, St. Patrick's Day and Easter. They will include classroom parties, crafts, customs, songs and stories.

Language Arts: alphabet upper and lower case, printing and beginning sounds. Sight words, left to right progression, opposites, rhymes, word families, positional prepositions and vowels-consonants-blends will be introduced. Stories, poems and show and tell will also be a part of our daily schedule.

Math: Counting to 100 by 1's and skip counting 2's, 5's, 10's. Simple addition, counting objects, number recognition and ordinal number counting 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, etc. Shapes, sizes, games, patterning, sequencing, graphing, simple measurement, matching for visual discrimination, telling time and money recognition will be introduced.

Music: Nursery rhymes, songs, poems, dancing and musical instruments.

Science: Weather, seasons, 5 senses, plants, solar system, insects, dinosaurs, mammals, reptiles, birds and farm animals.

Social Studies: All about Me, families, people in the community, famous people, US and world maps, 50 states, food pyramid, other countries cultures and customs and creative play.

This curriculum will be very helpful for your future Kindergartener. We will work hard on it at school and they will need to work on it at home as well.

Young 5's / Pre Kindergarten Daily Schedule

6:30-8:30 a.m.	Arrival - morning centers Breakfast is served 7:30-8:30 a.m.
8:30-8:45 a.m.	Clean up, bathroom, wash hands, and drink of water.
8:45-9:00 a.m.	Exercise/dance.
9:00-9:15 a.m.	Circle Time - Morning greeting, calendar, story time, Music and lesson explanation.
9:15-10:30 a.m.	Project and Activity Centers.
10:30-11:10 a.m.	Circle Time - Sight words, Geography, and Show and Tell and recall.
11:10-11:20 a.m.	Bathroom, wash hands and drinks.
11:20-11:50 a.m.	Outdoor play/indoor play scape.
11:50-12:00 p.m.	Wash hand and eat lunch.
12:00-12:30 p.m.	Lunch served.
12:30-1:00 p.m.	Bathroom, wash hands, prepare of nap and nap time story.
1:00-3:00 p.m.	Nap/rest time.
3:00-4:00 p.m.	Bathroom, wash hands, drinks snacks and choice centers/ games.
4:00-4:30 p.m.	Clean up, story time, bathroom, wash hands and drinks.
4:30-5:15 p.m.	Outdoor play/indoor play scape
5:15-6:00 p.m.	Dismissal- choice time and parent pickup.

Circle Time - Includes morning greeting, calendar, weather, theme of the week, project, Geography, Math, Language Arts, stories and Show and Tell.

Project/Centers - Children make their projects and when completed they may go to activity centers. Centers consist of creative play, reading, science, building blocks, games, puzzles, writing and art.

Lunch Time - Rosey's lunch will be provided or you may provide your own lunch for your child. No peanut products please.

Nap/Quiet Time - Your child will need bedding and may bring a small stuffed animal or soft doll (that does not make noises) for rest time.

Snack Time - Snack is provided by Rosey's or it may be a Birthday treat.
